Preservation and improvement of reproductive health has special significance in each society, especially in those characterized by low birth rates. Therefore, measures for improvement of reproductive health of adolescents, for healthy motherhood and infertility problem-solving are significant elements of strategic activities in developed countries, with the aim to achieve simple replacement of generations. Particularly significant is the role of some Ministries – Health and Social Welfare, Culture, Education and Sports. The
